

## Family Together on Sunday: 29.03.20

**Today's Teaching:** Mark 14 v 1-25 (the Beginners Bible p442, Jesus Story Book Bible p292)

**Big Idea:** *Don't forget Jesus – he is worth everything because of his death for us*

**Ready?** It will help if you have a **perfume/simple bottle, bread and red juice.**

There are two parts to today teaching, you might want to use two different spaces in the house to teach it. Set up the second scene on the table you normally eat at.

### ➡ **Starter:**

Think of something kind someone has done for you? You could get out some family/friends photos so that the children can talk about the kind things they have done for them.

Who are the people you have remembered this week and done kind things for? Who have you rung? Done shopping for, sent a letter to.

In today's passage Jesus shows us it is important to remember him



**Passage:** Today's teaching is written in two parts

### **Part One:**

**Read v1-2** What big festival is happening? What are the leaders plotting to do?

**Read:** Mark 14 v 3 - 11 (if your feeling up to it act it out with people or figures)

How did the woman treat Jesus? What does this show about what she thought of him? V3

What did the people in the room think of the woman? V4

What did Jesus think of the woman? V6

What did Jesus say the woman was doing? V7&8

*Extension: How did Jesus react to what had happened? Why is this so surprising?*

*What does it show about what he thought of Jesus?*

### **Part Two:** (to be done on the table)

**Read v12-16** It's time for the festival – what does Jesus tell the disciples to do?

**Read v 17 – 21** What does Jesus say is going to happen? How do the disciples react?

**Read v22** What is the first picture what does it represent?

**Read v 23** What is the second picture, what does it represent?

**Read v 24-25** What event is remembered with the bread and the wine?

*Extension: Passover and the festival of Unleavened bread was a party to help people remember another event in the Bible what was that?*

*What is the timing of what Jesus is doing/about to do significant?*
