

Ukraine Emergency

The invasion of Ukraine and the ensuing crisis has led to many in church wondering how they can give practically and financially to those most affected. There are many routes for financial giving direct to Ukraine Christian Ministries and ministries working in bordering countries helping those fleeing the war. Within Highfields congregation there are church members with links to those helping refugees directly or in Ukrainian ministry. We've tried to compile a brief list of those who you may be interested in supporting:

Tearfund

Tearfund does not usually operate in Europe. Our call is to go where the need is greatest around the world – following Jesus into conflicts that aren't always in the spotlight. However, as the scale of the crisis in Ukraine unfolds, as Christians we cannot stand by in silence. As a member of the Disasters Emergency Committee and Integral Alliance, we're supporting partners on the ground to provide food, bedding and temporary accommodation to refugees from Ukraine.

Samaritans Purse

Samaritan's Purse has long been partnering with more than 3,200 churches inside Ukraine. As conflict erupted, we were in the process of distributing 600,000 Operation Christmas Child gift-filled shoeboxes. We remain in contact with ministry partners in the country to see how we can assist during this crisis. Please pray for God to grant them strength and protection.

The main ministry of Barnabas Fund is to send financial support to projects which help Christians where they suffer discrimination, oppression, and persecution as a consequence of their faith. Their partners in Ukraine have long experience of distributing food through local churches to Christians in poor areas, both in the capital Kyiv and in rural regions. The need is now far greater.
