18th – 31st March 2024

We hope that you find this a useful prompt for your daily prayers as we run this week of events seeking to reach out and spread a passion for Jesus together in our local community. We long for God's gracious favour and to see fruit as we step out in mission together – that it might be all for His glory.

For each day this month you'll find a short prayer to join with us as we prayerfully consider the different aspects of mission. These prayers fall under each of the following headings:

- ❖ **Compassion:** Compassionate hearts (for us), that we'd be moved to mission!
- ❖ **Gospel fuel:** that we'd be reminded afresh of God's glorious gospel of grace and be encouraged anew by our own salvation
- ❖ **Fruit:** Soft hearts for those we invite, that they would say yes and come along
- ❖ **Life:** that we would remember ourselves the life that Jesus offers us in His name
- ❖ **God's glory:** that this would always be our chief aim as we step out in mission (and indeed do our every day)
